About the Seminar

The increasing degradation of rivers, loss of ecological services, livelihood, cultural & other values have drawn attention of common-men, environmentalists and governments. The demand to maintain upper portion of rivers in natural state and to enact legislation for protecting threatened stretches of iconic rivers, namely: Ganga, Yamuna, Ramganga, Kali, Gomti, and Hindon etc. traversing through Upper Ganga Basin is growing. Dying of fishes in want of adequate oxygen level in river-waters, presence of arsenic and other pollution in groundwater and disturbed stream-aquifer water table equilibrium under threats of climate change and as a result rivers loosing longitudinal, vertical and linear connectivity. Everybody today is talking for Healthy rivers for ecosystems benefits and prosperity. Certainly the success of 'Namami Ganges' programme lies on shoulders of wise-citizenry and river's bank communities.

We are familiar that ecology, economy and social development and even life itself cannot be sustained

without sufficient water at the right time and place and of appropriate quality. Rivers fulfil many important functions and support freshwater aquatic livelihood. Encroachment on water bodies, disappearance of ponds, lakes and wetlands and mining of groundwater, all these issues are challenging engineering fraternity and policy planners. Recent drought in Bundelkhand region and floods in many more states gives opportunity to act and now.

This seminar is proposed to advance the water management by professionals, researchers and policy framers, educators and others with a forum for sharing information about the appropriate use and management of water resources to river health and to river basin planning and management for future needs. The recommendations of the seminar shall be sent to governments for policy shift and implementation on the ground.
